

Call for Junior Trainer

EuroPeers Training Course

25-28 March 2021, Online

We are looking for **2 junior trainer/s** who will be involved in the preparation and carrying out of a 4-days Online EuroPeers training course (English-speaking) in cooperation with two senior trainers, who are selected separately.

Aim of the TC

The training course aims at empowering the participants to share their experience and act as multipliers for the European Youth Programmes on a Peer-level. At the same time, the participants become part of the international EuroPeers-network which offers many diverse opportunities for participation and networking.

In summary, the training pursues the following aims:

- Network – Integrate participants into the EuroPeers-network, further development of the network
- Share – Convey methodological and general knowledge about the European Youth Programmes supporting participants to share their own experience with peers
- Empower – Development of new knowledge and skills (project management, PR activities, chairing and presentation techniques, etc.)

Participants will exchange their experience and good practice and will be encouraged to undertake actions as EuroPeers after the training course (with support from the trainers after the TC).

Target group of the TC

Young people who took part in Erasmus+ YOUTH IN ACTION and European Solidarity Corps projects:

- who are motivated to share their experiences with peers
- who want to raise awareness among young people of European issues and activities;
- who want to show how cultural diversity can be brought to life and encourage their peers to reflect critically on Europe and EU policy;
- who feel confident to express themselves in English;
- who are committed to attend the full duration of the course;
- who are at least 18 years old;
- residents of countries which are part of the EuroPeers-network.

Team

- 2 senior trainers - responsible for programme flow, methodology and final report
- 2 supporting junior trainer/s
- Representative of National Agency, responsible for the organisational part of the training and content-related resource persons (concept, info about Erasmus+ YiA/European Solidarity Corps, promotion of the training, co-operation with other NAs, recruitment of participants, logistics, etc.)

Junior Trainers' profile

Candidates shall:

- be an active EuroPeer
- have interest in developing their trainer skills;
- have experience in non-formal education;
- have some experience in organizing (online) workshops or assisting in youth projects;
- have some basic knowledge about the Erasmus+ YOUTH IN ACTION Programme, the European Solidarity Corps and other mobility programmes in Europe;
- have very good knowledge of English language

Tasks / duties of trainers

The tasks of the trainer include the following:

- to be prepared before and actively attend the online preparatory meeting for the concept development (**End of January/Beginning of February 2021**);
- to attend the full training course (25-28 March 2021) and follow-up event
- to assist in designing, preparing, delivering and evaluating the training and follow-up event together with other team members;
- to assist in preparing the final report together with the other trainers;
- to stay in contact with participants before and after the TC (supporting and motivating the participants in their EuroPeer actions).

Junior Trainer's fee

8 paid days (100 € per day) = 800 € (gross)

- 4 working days during the training course;
- 1 day for a virtual Follow-up event
- 3 days for preparation and evaluation (fixed amount including individual and team preparation, prep-meeting, on-going and final evaluation directly after the training + final report; prep-meeting dates and final report are not extra paid);
